

## **DIRECTIONS TO THE FORUM FROM I-95**

Exit I-95 (westbound) at Atlantic Boulevard in Pompano Beach. You will be turning left (south) at the first traffic light after I-95. It is marked as Andrews Avenue/SW 12 Avenue. *(If you cross the railroad tracks, you have gone too far, so turn around and go back to the traffic light before I-95.)*

Turn left (south) onto Andrews Avenue/SW 12 Avenue. As soon as you turn, the road will curve to the left and immediately back to the right, (an .S. configuration). Follow the road to the first traffic light. The cross street is identified as SW 3 Street/John Knox Village Boulevard. Turn left onto that street and you will immediately start over an I-95 overpass. From the top of the overpass, look ahead to the right and will see a tan, circular building. That is The Forum. Their drive is to the right, the first street coming off of the I-95 overpass. The Forum is easy to find. These directions are written in more detail than you will need. Please do not allow them to frighten you.

## **GETTING BACK TO I-95 FROM THE FORUM**

At the stop sign at the end of The Forum driveway, turn left (west) onto SW 3 Street/John Knox Village Boulevard. *(Cross traffic is coming down an overpass, so please be very careful.)* After turning onto SW 3 Street/John Knox Village Boulevard, you will immediately start over I-95. At the traffic light at the foot of the overpass, you will be turning right (north) on Andrews Avenue. Follow the “S” curves on Andrews Avenue. The traffic light three blocks ahead is Atlantic Boulevard, where you will turn right (east). Stay in the right lane.

The entrance to southbound I-95 (toward Miami) appears to the right as soon as you turn right onto Atlantic Boulevard. The entrance to northbound I-95 (toward West Palm Beach) is also to the right, just after you cross under I-95 on Atlantic Boulevard.
