Psalm 51

Have mercy on and , O God, according to your unfailing love; according to your great compassion blot out our transgressions.

Wash away all our iniquities and cleanse us from our sin. For and know our transgressions and our sin is always before us. Against you, you only, have we sinned and done what is evil in your sight; so you are right in your verdict and justified when you judge. Surely we were sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me. Yet you deserved faithfulness even in the womb; you taught us wisdom in that secret place.

Cleanse us with hyssop, and we will be clean; wash us and we will be whiter than snow. Let us hear joy and gladness; let the bones you have crushed rejoice. Hide your face from our sins and blot out all our iniquity.
